Five days a week, Mission Without Borders Soup Kitchen staff and volunteers visit 49 households in Sarny to provide hot meals and help to the poor. Often these are the only visitors they ever get.

"Winter time is a painful period for many of our elderly that we serve. Most live in old, very cold houses in poor repair." - Volodymyr, local coordinator

Please pray that Volodymyr and his team can help bring hope and help to people like this 90-year-old woman. She cannot walk and is very ill.

Kateryna's family's income is about \$48 aud per month. It is difficult to survive on such a small amount and when Kateryna couldn't afford to pay for utilities, their electricity was cut off. They heat their home with firewood.

"These people say that God inspires them to do these things for others. I'm not strong in faith, but their attitude shows me what Christian faith looks like.
