Thanksgiving

- 1 We give thanks to God for being our sustainer and provider. All glory to Christ for His presence by our side in all that we do.
- 2 Praise God that He alone can save, constantly working in the lives of those we serve to bring them to Him, restoring their hearts to know Him as their Creator and King.
- 3 We give thanks to God for our Summer Camps, and for all the children who accepted Jesus into their hearts as personal Saviour. We pray that they would not give up seeking the Lord, and that they would be guided in their faith as they grow up.
- 4 We Praise the Lord and give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever. (Psalms 106:1)
- 5 Praise God for the families in our programs that are reaching self-sufficiency. We thank God for the new hope they've been given and pray that they would continue to depend on Christ as they reach a new and exciting season in life.

Albania

- 6 We praise God for all the sponsors that are generous and loyal to MWB in Albania, supporting the needy families we serve and bringing physical and spiritual peace in their lives.
- 7 Praise God for the children in our Family-to-Family program in Albania, and how their lives have been positively impacted. We pray for their education as they start a new academic year in September.
- 8 Pray for the teachers of our After-School Clubs, as children depend on them to meet their needs and fill the gaps in their education. May God sustain them, giving them wisdom and clarity as they teach.
- 9 Please pray that God would help us amidst the high prices that continue to rise and negatively affect our lives. Pray that we would look to Christ for hope and depend on Him as our provider.
- 10 We ask God to send a revival of the Holy Spirit across our work, according to Isaiah 44:3 and Matthew 3:11. We pray for commitment and a dedicated passion, under God's guidance.
- 11 We ask God to strengthen the single parents in our communities during their daily difficulties of looking after their children and homes.

Bosnia-Herzegovina

- 12 Praise God for each volunteer and sponsor who made our Summer Camps possible this year in Bosnia-Herzegovina. May the seeds planted in children's hearts grow as they return home to their families, never forgetting what they learned about Jesus.

- 13 Please pray for the general well-being of families in our programs, as many are struggling with health challenges. Pray for protection and healing, especially as our complicated healthcare system creates more difficulties.

- 14 Please pray for the Karalić family: the 30-year-old mother was diagnosed with ovarian cancer and is undergoing additional tests. May God cover their family with His protection, bringing healing and restoration.

- 15 Pray for parents in Bosnia-Herzegovina who face the pressure of providing their children with everything needed for the new academic year, so that they can attend regular schooling. May God provide for these families so that children can experience education and a good future.

- 16 We lift up our After-School Clubs in Bosnia-Herzegovina, and all the new students joining us. May our program be a blessing to them and a place where they feel welcome, joyful and excited to study and grow.

- 17 Pray for the stabilisation of the political situation in the country; Bosnia is facing significant political challenges that threaten its stability and territorial integrity. May people lift their eyes to God as their firm foundation during these troubled times.

Bulgaria

- 18 Pray for the health of those in our Sponsorship Program, as many of them have been hospitalised with serious respiratory problems and are struggling to recover. May our team demonstrate God's love and point them to Christ as their healer.
- 19 Praise God for His immense love and mercy towards us, caring for our team in Bulgaria and the needs of those we journey with. May we always serve Him wholeheartedly, and may our work give Him all the glory.
- 20 Please pray for our Street Mercy team, for God to give them strength, wisdom, and all they need as they help many lonely and abandoned people. May these interactions bring people to Christ.
- 21 Please pray that God would protect the health of our coordinators, sustaining them with the energy and physical well-being so that they can enjoy their tasks and serve with glad hearts.
- 22 Pray for wisdom as we discern how to best help each person and family, getting to know them so that we can offer personal support that is unique to them.
- 23 Pray for the education of older students in the communities we serve. May our scholarships and vocational courses lead many adults into brighter futures and renew their sense of self.

Moldova

- 24 We thank God for the 60 families receiving Self-Sufficiency Projects in Moldova this year. Please pray that this will encourage them to increase their household income and shift their mindset, empowering them to break the cycle of poverty.
- 25 Pray for the healing and restoration of marriages across Moldova, where divorce rates are high. Pray against division

in families and for children who are affected by separated parents who need emotional healing, stability and love. May there be support systems in churches and communities to help couples through challenges.

- 26 Pray for young people who face distractions, addictions, and unhealthy behaviours. May their hearts be freed from these chains, rediscovering truth, love, and purpose. We ask God to give their parents wisdom as they raise children to become adults in a world with many temptations.
- 27 Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal the Word of God during our Women's Meetings, as many of these women raise their children alone and need strength. Pray for God's truth to take root, and that they will turn to the Lord for refuge, instead of falling into harmful habits.
- 28 We lift up our Bible course, praying that the Lord would touch children's hearts through it, drawing them closer to Him. May His Word take root and bear fruit in their lives.
- 29 We ask our mighty God to bring a spiritual awakening across Moldova. May the Lord strengthen the church, raise up passionate leaders, and bring many to faith.
- 30 Please pray for more job opportunities and economic development in our country. Pray especially for the younger generation to find work, so that fewer Moldovans leave the country to find work abroad.
- 31 We pray for all the mothers who feel lonely in Moldova, whether fathers have abandoned their families or have had to work abroad for a season. May they feel the comforting presence of Christ, knowing that He never abandons or leaves us.

- 9 We lift up the new combined After-School Club and Soup Kitchen being established in Neamt County. May it greatly encourage the community and bear fruit in the children's lives, improving their grades at school as well as their nutrition.
- 10 Please pray for God to protect our country from the war that is close to our borders. May our eyes look to the Lord for peace, and may He give our leaders wisdom and cover us in His safety.
- 11 Pray that the children growing up in our programs would find their identity rooted in Christ. May they know God's unconditional love and become adults with a mature faith and understanding of Him.

Ukraine

- 12 Pray for our coordinators as they work with new communities for our Children in Communities Program. Pray that they will build good connections with local churches and volunteers, and that new children will have a smooth enrolment process. Praise God for this opportunity to serve more people!
- 13 We praise God for the successful academic year of students at our Sarny Vocational Education Centre. May they apply their knowledge and skills in their next steps and receive good, stable jobs.
- 14 Praise God for the summer holidays that children have enjoyed. May they feel rested and motivated to study again. Pray that our distribution of backpacks will bring joy and care to those who receive them.
