JUNE 2025

Thanksgiving

- 1 Let us give thanks to God for His faithfulness to Mission Without Borders. We thank the Lord for how He has cared for us and continues to care for us every day.
- 2 **Family G (Sarny, Ukraine):** Praise God that the father's situation has improved, as well as his spiritual state. He says he has felt God's guidance and grace in everyday challenges, and is grateful for the support, knowing that many people have prayed for him and his family!
- 3 We give thanks for how God has carried us through the Easter season, bringing more people to Him through our events. Pray that these people continue to seek God, and that our teams would be wise in following up with them as they take steps in faith.
- 4 **Family T (Ukraine):** We give thanks to God that the father who badly injured both heels can now walk by himself a bit. Please continue to pray for his full recovery.
- 5 Praise God for all our collaborators: churches, volunteers, and pastors. We thank God for their dedication, and for how God is using them as His hands and feet.
- 6 **Family K (Ukraine):** We thank God for the successful operation to remove the mother's brain tumour. Please continue to pray for any further treatment, that it would be effective and bring complete healing.

Pray for healing

- 7 **Bosnia-Herzegovina:** Pray for the restoration of health for V.M., a 39 year old father. His condition is very bad, with small chances of improvement. Please pray for his family to have strength, patience, comfort and peace.
- 8 **Bulgaria:** Pray for Mohamed (13), whose condition is very serious after suffering a serious accident, resulting in severe burns to his face. Please pray for God's guidance over the medical professionals involved, for his parents to have peace, and for Mohamed's full recovery.
- 9 **Romania:** Pray for pastor Timotei from one of our local partner churches. He is undergoing medical tests due to sickness. Pray for God's protection to be over him, and that highly skilled doctors would give him the right diagnosis and treatment.
- 10 **Ukraine:** We pray for God's miraculous healing to cover over people who have suffered trauma due to the ongoing war. May God give them peace, restoring their mental health and giving them hope.

Summer Camps

- 11 Please pray that the hearts of children who attend Summer Camps would be open to accepting the Gospel. Pray that the leaders and activities would show them God's love, giving them an experience that changes their lives.
- 12 We ask God to bring more volunteers forward for our Summer Camps. In Ukraine, it has been challenging finding people who are available due to the war, and in Bulgaria, they are in need of musicians.
- 13 We thank God for how Summer Camps give children an opportunity to take a break from their daily worries, routines, and responsibilities. We pray that they will feel free to simply be children, and that they will understand what it means to find rest in Christ.
- 14 Please pray for the Summer Camps in Ukraine, that no obstacles would get in the way of them running during the war. May God protect the volunteers, staff, children, and camp facilities, and may children have a week of joy in a safe and loving environment, away from the realities of war.
- 15 Please pray for the Holy Spirit to be moving across all campsites and countries, drawing children's attention to Jesus. Pray for coordinators to be God's hands and feet, having His wisdom and being good examples for children to look up to.
- 16 Please pray for all the logistical preparation needed to bring these camps to life. Pray for good deals and contracts with campsite owners and transportation companies, as some countries are running camps across various locations in their country.
- 17 Please pray that children would leave Summer Camps with not only new life skills, friends and memories, but also new hope. May God continue to move in their lives after the week away, rippling into their families and being a testimony of God's transformative love.

Albania

- 18 Pray for the seniors in the communities we serve in Albania. May God provide for their needs, strengthening and helping them face life with hope.
- 19 We ask God to sustain the single parents we journey with, providing for their needs and encouraging them. May they know Jesus to be a good and faithful friend in times of loneliness, and may we display God's love to them.
- 20 Pray for the families that are implementing Self-Sufficiency Projects. May God bless their efforts and improve their incomes through these projects, helping them provide for their families and gain confidence in their skills.
- 21 We lift up to God the abandoned elderly we serve through the Soup Kitchens and Senior care projects. Pray that through our care, they would experience community and support.

Bosnia-Herzegovina

- 22 We give thanks for all supporters across the world who have been supporting and praying for us. We praise God for the opportunities that families have been able to receive through it, and pray for their fruitfulness.
- 23 Please pray for a successful agricultural season, asking God for favourable conditions that will lead to a plentiful harvest of crops across many gardens this year.
- 24 Pray that families receiving Self-Sufficiency Projects in Bosnia-Herzegovina would use the opportunity as a springboard in their lives towards achieving self-sustainability. May God give them motivation and inspiration as they work hard and learn new skills.
- 25 Please pray for our team as we juggle various programs and events. May God give us unity in Christ and wisdom as we deepen relationships with people who are in need, discerning how we can serve them well.

Bulgaria

- 26 We give thanks to God for the precious newborns and children growing up in our programs. Praise God for the parents whose lives are transforming, embracing the Lord and His teachings. May this be reflected in the lives of younger generations.
- 27 Praise God for enabling our Bible lessons to continue at the disabled clubs. May these be a blessing to many people, deepening their understanding of what it looks like to follow Jesus.
- 28 Please pray for God to give us new volunteers to help our team, and that it would bring balance to our workload and grow our capacity so that we can serve God well.
- 29 Please pray that the homeless people we work with would not only undergo physical transformation, but spiritual transformation as well. May they turn towards Jesus and view themselves with dignity, seeing how they have been made in His image.
- 30 Please pray that God would give our team wisdom and inspire us through His Word, renewing us with each new day as we depend on Him to carry out our tasks.

JULY 2025

Thanksgiving

- 1 Praise God for the support we can bring to many families living in poverty, raising the standards of living in their communities. May our work continue to reflect God's compassion and justice.
- 2 Praise God for the construction tools that various families have received through our Self-Sufficiency Projects in recent months. May God bless these resources and continue to provide for these families through them.
- 3 **Zhivka (Bulgaria):** Praise God for Zhivka, who was sick with a tumour and underwent several operations. We have been

praying for her, and now she is well and healed – Praise God for being the ultimate healer.

- 4 Praise God for how He has enabled us to support many generations of people: children, adults, parents, and the elderly. May God continue to reveal how we can best support individuals as we journey with them.
- 5 We give thanks that God hears our prayers and is faithful to answer them. We surrender all of Mission Without Borders' plans to Him, trusting Him to work through staff and volunteers here in Australia, and in Eastern Europe.

Pray for healing

- 6 **Family K (Rivne, Ukraine):** Please pray for the mother who is struggling with cancer and undergoing chemotherapy. Pray that the treatment is effective, and for the spiritual and emotional wellbeing of the family.
- 7 **Family A (Sarny, Ukraine):** Please pray for the mother, whose kidney failed. Pray for doctors to have wisdom and that God would help the family navigate this season.

- 8 **Bulgaria:** Pray for Snezhana (76), a single woman, who has multiple diagnoses and limited mobility. She was in hospital and now she is back home. Pray for a full recovery and for her to accept God as her Saviour.
- 9 **Bulgaria:** We lift up Asya, a mother of two daughters who have now become volunteers. She has been diagnosed with a fear neurosis, impacting the entire family. Pray for God's peace in her mind and for the family to find rest in Christ.

Moldova

- 10 Pray for the school break, asking God to keep children safe from accidents, neglect, or harmful influences. Pray for access to positive activities, caring supervision, and opportunities to grow in healthy ways. May churches and communities create safe spaces where children feel valued and protected.
- 11 Please pray for the families and children, who have ended up with complications in hospital due to a seasonal virus affecting many. We ask God to protect their wellbeing and restore them.
- 12 Please pray for farmers in Moldova, as they have dealt with unexpected frosts. We ask God to bless their land and work, bringing favourable weather and providing for those who depend on the fruit of the earth.
- 13 Please pray for the organisation of our agricultural seminar. Pray that it would provide people with valuable information on how to develop their household through agriculture, and that God would use this in their journey towards self-sufficiency.
- 14 Pray for students who will be taking their last session of the academic year. May God help them memorise important information and bless their paths as they become responsible adults. Pray that those graduating would find stable jobs that will equip them in life.

Romania

- 15 Praise God for the children and adults who have started to attend a church through Mission Without Borders. May they be encouraged in their walk with Christ.

- 16 We give thanks for Laurentiu (13), who has had heart surgery, and is feeling well. Praise God that he is able to participate in our programs, and continue to pray for his full recovery.

- 17 We give thanks for Julia, a student in Romania under our Scholarship Program who has now completed all 3 years of her Tourism Geography studies. May God bless her knowledge and understanding of this field and prepare a path for her to receive further work.

- 18 Please pray for the Self-Sufficiency Projects that coordinators will be purchasing for some families in Romania. May this be a big step towards self-sustainability for these families, and may coordinators encourage them to keep up their work outside of their visits.

- 19 We lift up the elderly in our program feeling lonely and rejected. May they be surrounded by people who will listen to their struggles, and may our support show them God's presence in their lives.

Ukraine

- 20 Praise God for the international support we receive, on both state and individual levels. We give thanks for dear friends, donors, and supporters who are helping our nation and people at all levels.

- 21 Please pray for displaced families, asking God to heal their hearts and souls, and that our coordinators will be ambassadors of hope for them.

- 22 We pray for our authorities, that God would give them wisdom and competence to run the country in a time of war. Pray for their unity and integrity, and that God would bless them.

- 23 Please pray for protection from missile attacks that bring destruction and harm. Pray for all people in the 'war regions,' living under unimaginable conditions daily. We ask God to keep people safe – those we serve and our families as well – as we face challenges and risks.

- 24 Pray for those of us whose family members serve in the army. May God preserve their lives and health, sustaining them with His hope.

- 25 Please pray for everyone who has lost loved ones in the war. May all the widows and orphans be consoled by the Holy Spirit, and the families be guided by the Lord's provision, lighting the path before them.

All Countries

- 26 We lift up Mission Without Borders' work, asking that "Your ways may be known on earth, Your salvation among all nations." (Psalm 67:2)

- 27 Please pray that the gospel message will be clear in our interactions, asking God to give our coordinators, staff, and volunteers the right words to say to those who need to hear of His salvation.

- 28 We pray that God would open doors for us to reach more people who are in need. May the right children, families, elderly, and homeless be brought into our programs, with new opportunities to show God's love.

- 29 Pray that across Eastern Europe, people living in poverty would undergo a transformation of their whole self: physically, emotionally, and spiritually. We ask God to restore the parts of people that are broken and needing attention, giving them new life in Him.
-
- 30 We lift up the women in our programs who have faced domestic violence and who live with poor economic and social status. We pray that our support can give them tangible hope, empowering and equipping them. May our work be a part of positive change in society, combatting injustices that women face and providing them safe refuge.

- 31 Please pray for the directors of Mission Without Borders in our 6 field countries. May God refresh their souls, and may they rest in Christ, depending on Him daily as they face new challenges.
