

Thanksgiving

Romania

- Please pray that our staff will be organised and efficient during these busy months. May God protect them as they travel to many places, organising events and visiting the people we serve.
- Please pray for our 233 volunteers who have been helping us facilitate our Christmas celebrations. Praise God for their passion and desire to show God's love through their actions.
- Pray that God would multiply the job opportunities across Romania. May God help families living in poverty to keep up with the increasing prices.

Ukraine

- Praise God that despite the war's strain on the educational process, we have completed another school year. We thank God for the children in Ukraine who have been blessed through education, as well as the students of our Vocational Education Centre in Sarny, and people in our Scholarship Program.
- Family L from Sarny lost their father in a car accident a few months

ago, making the mother a widow with 6 small children. Pray for the mother's emotional wellbeing as she mourns her husband, and that God would comfort the entire family.

- Family K's father has been mobilised into military service, and the mother and sons have serious health issues. Please pray for the father's safe and quick return, so that the family can have support again.
- For families starting up Self-Sufficiency Projects, we ask for successful implementation and that God would make this final step to self-sufficiency a fruitful blessing in their lives.
- As the harvesting season comes to an end, pray for families who rely on their small pieces of land to provide food to last the winter. May God grow up an abundance of crops to last this difficult season.
- Pray that God would give us the right words when we encounter people suffering trauma and great losses because of the war. May God's message of love and comfort be spoken through us. Please also pray for our team, as we also need to be renewed spiritually and emotionally.
- Pray for the world's support during this war. We desperately need our friends' and partners' support, encouraging us with the belief that we can overcome these hardships by remaining united. We thank God for all the help and intercessory prayers that have been lifted up on our behalf.
- Please pray for this terrible war to end. May God protect every Ukrainian individual and family with His strong and everlasting shield.
- Please pray for the new academic year in Ukraine. May God keep education opportunities open and give teachers the wisdom and capabilities needed to support children.
