- 14 Pray for the Albanian MWB team. May God equip them with perseverance and a desire to bring hope to those who have lost it, making them His instruments in the world.
- 15 Pray for God to give our staff and volunteers great wisdom as they share the Gospel with people in our programs. May God open hearts to hear His word and receive it.
- 16 Pray for children returning to school, that they will stay focused on their education and grow in wisdom.
- 17 Praise God for the school materials that allow children in our programs to learn more effectively. Pray that more children will have the opportunity to receive education.

- 24 Pray for more job opportunities in Bosnia-Herzegovina, as people living in poverty struggle to secure a stable job. May God open the right doors for families in need.

BULGARIA

- 25 Pray for homeless people who are vulnerably living on the streets. May God protect their health, provide them with food, and lead them along the path of everlasting life.
- 26 Pray for God to give the Bulgaria staff team unity, wisdom, and spiritual renewal.
- 27 Pray for the many people in our programs who suffer from chronic illnesses. May God protect their health, especially during seasons when viruses are more threatening.

- 10 Praise God for the willing servants who prepare meals at our Soup Kitchens. May God bless the work of their hands and fill them with His joy.

MOLDOVA

- 11 Pray for the children in Moldova who are stepping into a new stage of education. May God give them encouragement in their studies, especially those who come from disadvantaged families where education is not always prioritised.
- 12 Please pray for the health of vulnerable people and families in Moldova. May God protect them from illness and injury and give them strength in the face of poverty.
- 13 Pray for young people who are becoming adults in Moldova. May God give them discernment for what will bear fruit in their lives, and keep them on a good path, giving them wisdom in their decisions.
- 14 Pray that God's provision will bring struggling families closer to economic stability, providing them with consistent and steady income and repaired homes to live in.
- 15 Pray for single mothers in Moldova who carry the weight of raising children while living in poverty. May God lift their burdens and provide for their needs.

ROMANIA

- 16 Continue to pray for Petru (13) who has leukaemia and is undergoing chemotherapy that is very hard on his body. His treatment has shown some improvement, but he is still in a dangerous condition. May God bring miraculous healing.
- 17 Pray for parents who are forced to leave their families because of hardship or work. May God give them more opportunities to return home, where their children wait eagerly for them.
- 18 Pray for students in Romania who receive scholarships for their education. May God help them to study hard and be good examples for younger generations to follow.
- 19 Pray for children in Romania, who each have their own ability to influence the country positively as they grow up. May God give them good opportunities for a bright future.
- 20 Pray for families who have suffered the loss of a family member. May God give them comfort, peace, and strength to ride the waves of grief, surrounding them with care.

UKRAINE

- 21 Pray for families whose fathers and sons are serving in the army. May God cover them in protection – sustaining their emotional, physical and spiritual health.
- 22 Pray for our programs to remain effective in providing vulnerable people stability, compassion, and practical help. May God bring transformation to Ukraine through our work.
- 23 Pray for the establishment of MWB's work in new Eastern Ukraine communities. May God give staff wisdom as He reveals the right steps forward.
- 24 Pray for our government as the war continues and hardship persists. May God grant them wisdom and unity in every decision that must be made.
- 25 Pray for our staff and volunteers who continue to serve amidst challenges, that God will give them safety, emotional strength, and renewed hope.
- 26 Pray for families whose loved ones have been reported missing at the frontlines of war. May God show mercy and bring good news to their families that they have been found.

PRAY FOR THE WORK OF MWB

- 27 Pray that more people will choose to support families in Eastern Europe, giving generously so God's work can reach more people through this organisation.
