JUNE 2026

THANKSGIVING

- 1 Praise God that He is the source of all good: "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows." (James 1:17)
- 2 Praise God for every person in Eastern Europe who has chosen to follow Jesus. May God give them the strength to run the race set before them with faith.
- 3 Praise God for all that He has enabled our teams to achieve this year already, and for how our staff and volunteers are connected by Christ as we work.
- 4 We give thanks for the elderly people in our programs. Praise God for the relationships formed through clubs and Bible lessons, giving them comfort and friendship.
- 5 Praise God for His faithfulness that protects, guides, and strengthens our staff every day. May we continue to depend on His mercy and grace in every trial and victory.
- 6 We thank the Lord for the local churches in Eastern Europe, and the hearts of those who serve so willingly. Through our partnership, we can better serve those who are needy.

PRAY FOR SUMMER CAMPS

- 7 Pray for health and protection as Summer Camps run across Eastern Europe. May God keep children, volunteers, and staff safe as they travel and arrive at campsites.
- 8 Pray for children who feel shy and unsure how to connect. May God give camp leaders wisdom as they encourage them to make friends and experience the freedom of childhood!
- 9 Pray for camp leaders as they tell Bible stories to children. May children hear God's word as truth and feel personally connected to it.
- 10 Pray for true change to take place in children's hearts. May God gently nudge them to trust and follow Him.

- 11 Pray for the stamina of camp leaders as they engage with children. May God give them energy and vibrancy, and use them to help children feel known and loved by God.
- 12 Pray for Summer Camp to have beautiful weather with sunshine. May children experience joy as they play games, laugh, and run around outside.

ALBANIA

- 13 Pray for families in our programs who care for children with disabilities and autism. May God bless them with wisdom, endurance, and peace.
- 14 Please pray for families starting up Self-Sufficiency Projects. May their efforts bear fruit, and may they see God's faithfulness as time passes.
- 15 Pray for children in our After-School program. We ask God to guide, encourage and motivate them in their learning as they complete homework.
- 16 We praise God for our local partners, may God continue to strengthen our collaboration and cooperation with each other, building these relationships so that others may be blessed.
- 17 Pray for peace within Albania, that leaders will act with wisdom, integrity, and justice. May communities have better quality of living, and receive useful social services.
- 18 Pray for the men in our programs, that they may find strength in the Lord, motivation to provide for their families, and open hearts to receive the Gospel.

BOSNIA-HERZEGOVINA

- 19 Pray for the end of the school year and children who have to choose a high school or university. May God guide their decisions and help them on the right path forward.

- 20 Pray that new Self-Sufficiency Projects will be stepping stones for families who are struggling. May God use them to bring to life new small businesses, additional income, or create more success for the work families are already doing.

- 21 Pray for Bogoljub, in our Senior Care program. He goes to kidney dialysis every third day, and is immobile. His son cares for him, but he needs the Lord's strength and help.

- 22 Pray for 43-year-old Dzevahira, who has been diagnosed with aggressive breast cancer. She is a mother of two boys, one of whom is seriously ill and needs full-time care. Pray for God to provide a miracle for their family.

- 23 Pray for the pastors of local churches we partner with. May God renew them to share His word with others, and refresh their faith in Him.

- 24 Pray for the vulnerable lives of babies within the communities we serve. May God protect their bodies from sickness, injury and hunger, and strengthen their parents.

BULGARIA

- 25 Praise God for His work in Family K from our Sponsorship Program. N.K. – a woman from a Muslim background – lost consciousness, but on the way to hospital she cried out to the Lord for help, and He healed her. She now attends an Orthodox church, devoting herself to prayer.

- 26 Praise God for enabling our work to continue in our elderly clubs, with regular Bible studies. Pray for the health of the elderly as they suffer from chronic conditions, and the winter months make them more vulnerable. May new members open their hearts to Christ.

- 27 Local authorities intend to demolish unauthorised housing structures in a community we work in. Many families are at risk of being left without shelter. Pray for God's wisdom and the most appropriate outcomes in this situation.

- 28 Pray for the migration situation in Bulgaria and all who are impacted by it. May God provide wisdom, compassion, and opportunities for ministry.

- 29 Pray for the staff on our team. May God restore us when we grow weary or tired, and provide us with physical and spiritual energy.

- 30 Pray for more miracles to come to the surface within the communities we work in, that God will write new stories and testimonies of His grace that can be shared with many.

THANKSGIVING

- 1 "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise – the fruit of lips that openly profess his name." (Hebrews 13:15) May the work of MWB be filled with sacrificial praise to Him who is worthy!

- 8 Pray for families attending our Agriculture Seminar, that God will use this to teach them new information and practical skills. May it be an opportunity for families to share their experiences with other families in the program.

- 9 Pray for the Self-Sufficiency Projects that families will receive. May families receive these as gifts from God, and use them as tools in their livelihood with hearts of thankfulness.

- 10 Pray for children starting school holidays from June to the end of August. May God give them joyful memories so that they return to school ready to continue their education.

- 11 Pray for our staff and volunteers to have wisdom when visiting families. May God give them words that speak the Lord's truth with gentleness and conviction.

- 12 Pray for the health of people in the communities we serve, asking God to heal those who are sick or wounded.

ROMANIA

- 13 Pray for fathers who are constantly searching for stable jobs. May God bless their desire to bring security to their homes, as well as the work of their hands.

- 14 Pray for children whose parents must travel for work. They deeply miss their parents and want all of the family to be together, but parents need to earn money for them. May God lift their emotional weight.

- 15 Pray for seniors in our programs to find belonging, purpose and connection. Pray that our time spent listening, praying, and giving practical help brings dignity and encouragement.

- 16 Pray for Romania amidst increased political tensions and slow economic growth. Pray for the country's leaders to govern with clarity and courage for the good of the nation.

- 17 Praise God, the prayers of the father in Family H have been answered – His wife has been healed of sickness and depression, and is well now!

- 18 Pray for Family N, especially for the father and two of the children who have brittle bone disease, suffering numerous fractures. May God have mercy on them.

- 19 Pray for Petru, 13, from Family A.P., as he suffers from terminal leukemia. We ask God for a miracle that transforms his life with the Spirit's healing touch.

UKRAINE

- 20 Pray for the protection of our cities from strikes and destruction, speaking Jesus' name against any plans to destroy heating, electricity, and water supply.

- 21 Pray for the leadership of Ukraine. May God guide and protect the people making decisions, and bless the friends, partners and allies across other countries.

- 22 Pray for newly enrolled Family S, whose young daughter suffers from regular seizures. May God bring these seizures to a stop in His mighty name, and bring healing.

- 23 Pray for a just and lasting peace in Ukraine – that the war will end, violence will cease, and people across every affected region will find healing in the Lord.

- 24 Pray for God to give strength and resilience to all who are suffering, displaced, or living in constant fear. May their minds experience peace and rest.

- 25 Pray for children who are growing up during the war. May God restore their childhoods with joyful memories.

PRAY FOR FAMILIES IN CRISIS

- 26 Pray for women, mothers and daughters who have experienced domestic violence. May God bring justice and restoration to their lives, giving them safety and peace.

- 27 Pray for homes with parents who battle addiction, especially with alcohol. May God remove the hold of these addictions and protect children in these families.

- 28 Pray for those who have lost family members, leaving them isolated and without support. May our work provide friendship and love in tangible ways.

- 29 Pray for families whose houses are unfinished and without access to water or electricity. May God provide for their needs and give them hope for a brighter future.

- 30 Pray for single parents, who carry heavy burdens. May they depend on God, who lifts their burdens and gives them good gifts of joy, comfort, and hope.
-
- 31 Pray for families experiencing severe or chronic sickness and injury. May God bring miracles of healing to their bodies and restore their health.
