PRAY FOR UKRAINE

- 1 We present to God all the challenges faced by our global community. We express gratitude that our hope transcends this world and rests in Him. "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." (Revelation 21:4).
- 2 Lord, bring an end to the conflict in Ukraine. May Your peace settle over this land and in the hearts of its people. We pray for justice and reconciliation to come to this nation, which has endured such pain.
- 3 God of protection, shield those in danger. Guard the lives of civilians and soldiers alike and provide safety for those in vulnerable regions.
- 4 We praise You, God for your almighty hand guiding the lives of those we serve, acknowledging Your power in transforming hearts and bringing new life. We pray for healing across Ukraine. Restore the land, communities, and hearts broken by destruction and war.
- 5 Lord, we lift up the leaders of Ukraine. Grant them wisdom, courage, and integrity as they guide their people through this crisis.
- 6 We continue to pray for those who are displaced. Lord, please provide for these people. Open doors for housing, employment, and education, and restore stability to their lives.

PRAY FOR THE CHURCH

- 7 God, uphold the local churches in Ukraine. Strengthen their leaders and congregations as they care for those in need and share the hope of the Gospel.
- 8 We pray that the people of Ukraine would find salvation. In this time of crisis, may You draw people to know Your truth and find peace in Your promises.
- 9 Lord, protect our pastors and those serving Your people through ministry. Shield them from harm as they serve and provide them with the resources they need to minister effectively.
- 10 We pray for the resources of every church that continues to keep its doors open to those in need. Lord, we ask that You fill their cupboards and their hearts as they walk alongside those in great need.
- 11 Let us pray for the global church. May God convict us to support Ukraine so that its people never feel abandoned or forgotten.
- 12 We thank You, Lord, for the resumption of regular Bible lessons. We pray that You work in the hearts of those who participate as they read Your Word together.

PRAY FOR FAMILIES

- 13 Lord, we ask that You bring comfort to every family separated by war. Make a way for families to be reunited and bring peace to those who cannot yet return.

- 16 We pray for Your guidance for parents as they support and raise their children. Lord, protect every child impacted by this war. Help parents find the right words and provide them with opportunities to preserve their children's innocence and safety.

- 17 Let us pray for families in despair. Lord, bring hope to them. May they be reminded of Your faithfulness and see Your Love through the work of MWB.

- 18 God, move more people to act on their faith—to put what they believe into action and help their neighbours in need. We give You praise for how You lead us.

- 21 Please pray for children in institutions. May they have adults around them to guide and comfort them. We ask that God be their mighty protector and guard their hearts.

- 22 Lord, we pray for those carrying invisible wounds of trauma. Grant strength to those experiencing anxiety, depression, and PTSD. May they find comfort in Your presence and access to the care they need for healing and recovery.

- 23 Almighty protector, we continue to pray for those facing a challenging winter made worse by war. Equip us to care for Your people in this harsh season.

- 24 We thank You, God, for every partnership and connection that provides support to those enduring immense trauma. We pray for more opportunities to open and for those in need to find the strength and courage to seek the help available to them.
