## FEBRUARY 2026

### THANKSGIVING

- 1 Praise God for all those who have started to attend local church services after being introduced through our programs. May they commit to Jesus wholeheartedly and experience transformed lives through Christ.
- 2 We thank God for the children and adults who have attended the Bible Correspondence Course. May they continue to pursue Christ with curiosity and sincere faith as they learn more about Him.
- 3 We lift up our thanks for each and every donor, supporter, and partner who supports Mission Without Borders, enabling the work that we do in Eastern Europe.
- 4 "Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18) Regardless of what this year brings us, we give thanks to God for His goodness!

### EDUCATION

- 5 Please pray for MWB staff and volunteers as we distribute many backpacks filled with school resources to children. Pray that enough school materials will be sourced and that many children can receive them with joy and excitement, blessing their education.
- 6 Praise God for the start of a new academic year, particularly in Ukraine, where the education system has suffered from the war. We pray that more families will break free from poverty by gaining access to education this year.
- 7 We lift up our After School Clubs, thanking God for the safe spaces they provide for children. We ask God that these clubs will continue in 2026 with enough helpers, growing children in their education and identity.
- 8 Many children are dropping out of school early, and an increasing number are becoming illiterate. Please pray that God will grow a desire in their hearts to stay in school, giving them dreams for the future.

- 9 Please pray for older students reaching the end of their studies. May God grow them in wisdom as they reach the next steps in education, and may they be good role models for the younger children.
- 10 Please pray for the parents of families, that God will give them stable jobs so they can better support their children. May God show them how important education for their children is in order to make their way out of poverty.

### ALBANIA

- 11 Pray for the men in the rural community of Fllaka, many of whom are leaving the country. Pray for them to take responsibility for their families, and for God to give hope and strength to wives and children who have been abandoned.
- 12 Pray for the Senior Care project and elderly people in our communities. May God fill their lives with joy and remove their loneliness. Please also pray for their sustained health.
- 13 Praise God for the families who have been able to move out of our program due to self-sufficiency! May they remain stable in this state, and may God continue to grow them in their faith as they enter a new season.
- 14 Pray for the children and young adults of new families enrolled in our programs, that their parents will allow them to attend our Christian activities and partner churches. May God soften hearts so that people can be drawn closer to Him.
- 15 Pray for our new communities and the coordinators who are working with new families. May God give them wisdom and compassion, making them messengers of the Gospel. Please also pray for the staff and volunteers of our partner churches and their families, as they serve faithfully!
- 16 Pray for Albanians to find the motivation to stay in their country rather than leave it. May God give them the hope they need to build their future here.

## BOSNIA-HERZEGOVINA

- 17 Pray for families who are sowing and growing seeds. May God make these endeavours fruitful for families and greatly bless them through the produce grown.

- 18 Pray for our coordinators to discern the right families for our programs. May God help them to connect with families who are eager to cooperate and willing to make necessary changes to move forward towards self-sustainability.

- 19 Pray that God will draw out people's skills and gifts as they progress in reaching self-sufficiency. May God help them to realise what they love and equip them through our projects to use these passions to make a living.

---

- 20 Please pray for the health of our team in Bosnia-Herzegovina. May God protect our staff and volunteers with His Spirit so that we can carry out His good work in all programs and events ahead of us.

---

- 21 Pray for God's guidance over the people and land of Bosnia-Herzegovina. May God give people hope and faith for a better future, and pour His blessings over them.

---

- 22 Pray for God's protection over families and children still struggling with the cold weather. Pray against the attacks of sickness and for God's strength to be within them each day.

## BULGARIA

- 23 Pray for the members of our disabled club who have not yet accepted Christ as their Saviour. Pray that God will reveal Himself clearly to them and for their decision to follow Him.

- 24 Pray for God's blessing over our country of Bulgaria. May God bring justice, peace, and spiritual renewal to its people.

- 25 Pray that God will protect our staff and volunteers. May God provide us with health, strength and wisdom in daily tasks.

- 26 Pray for the Self-Sufficiency Projects in Bulgaria, that through them God will grow families in faith, hope, and inspiration as they work hard.

- 27 Please pray for parents who are struggling to put food on the table. May God provide these families with food to sustain them each day. We thank God for seeing their needs and may He give them faith in His provision.

- 28 Praise God for our volunteers who serve those in need. Please pray that God will bring more volunteers who are willing and excited to serve.

- 9 Pray that God will open the right doors as Easter approaches. May God allow our staff to connect new families, children, the elderly, and the homeless into our programs so that they can experience Easter with us.

---

- 10 Pray for the local churches we partner with, that God will strengthen them in all their work for the Easter season. May God give them enough volunteers and inspire them with fresh energy as they serve.

---

- 11 Please pray that God will soften the hearts of people in the lead-up to Easter. For those who have turned away from God, may they be open to His Spirit again, and may God give people new curiosity for what life in Christ looks like.

## MOLDOVA

- 12 Pray for families as they come out of the winter season and still face the harsh reality of poverty. Pray especially for an increase in job opportunities. May God give them encouragement and support this month.

- 13 Pray for the protection and shelter of the homeless people in our Street Mercy program, with no place to stay. May God provide them with food, clothing, and safe environments.

- 14 We give thanks for the wonderful volunteers and staff who serve at our Soup Kitchens, asking God to bless their hands and renew their strength.

- 15 Pray for the strength, health, and comfort of the elderly we support. May God surround them with people who show them love and give practical help.
- 
- 16 Pray for families facing financial hardship, that basic needs like heat, food, clothing and security will be met. May God fill their homes with peace and unity, despite their challenges.

- 17 Pray for God to work in the hearts of families, providing real solutions to their struggles as He teaches them to depend on Him as their rock and foundation.
- 
- 18 Pray for the children in our programs, that the seed of God's truth will take root in their hearts and grow into strong, healthy morals and values that will guide their lives.

## ROMANIA

- 19 Pray for the coordinators in Romania, asking God to help them speak His words over the children and families we serve. May they have God's wisdom, love and patience, whether they deliver goods, pray, or give advice.

- 20 Pray for the Bible Correspondence Course. May it be a light in the darkness as children receive letters about God, answering their small and mighty prayers.
- 
- 21 Pray that future sponsor visits to Romania will be eye-opening for those attending, providing people with a better understanding of the country, culture, and context we live in.

- 22 Pray for our Christian Outreach activities, that more children and parents will attend and have their hearts opened to God and all He has in store for their lives.

- 23 Pray for the entire country to be blessed by God. May our leaders love their people and have the fear of God, carrying the spirit of truth and humility as they serve the country.
- 
- 24 Pray for children who come from harsh backgrounds, that God will give them the strength to overcome their struggles and choose their paths wisely as they grow.

## UKRAINE

- 25 Pray for the families in our communities to have working utilities – electricity, heating, and running water – and that God will protect their homes from being hit by destruction.

- 26 Pray for our Christian Outreach team and their activities. May God use the team to share the light of Christ amidst the war, transforming many lives through them.
- 
- 27 May God prepare many families to receive Self-Sufficiency Projects in Ukraine this year, encouraging their hearts.
- 
- 28 Pray for our defenders, the brave army who have been protecting us on the battlefield. May God protect their health and lives, providing for all their needs.
- 
- 29 Please pray for our president, government, and local authorities. Pray for the wise and virtuous leadership of the country during these challenging times.
- 
- 30 Join us in praying for the people in our communities who have been drafted into the army. Pray for their safe and healthy return home after their service, and that God will take away the stress of their families as they wait for them.
- 
- 31 Pray for everyone who is suffering from trauma. May God be their everlasting peace and comfort, healing their minds, bodies, and hearts from the hurt they have experienced.
